



Bonner International Summer of Service 2016

Two grants of up to \$2,500 each will be awarded for an international service project/community work at one site. The criteria include whether applicant has had previous international experience, the quality and feasibility of proposal, length of stay, and performance as a Bonner. **All students receiving funding will be required to attend the all-day GO! Global Initiative on Culture and Ethics Conference on Saturday, April 2, 2016, at the Global Education Center, write a weekly blog, and present to Bonners after your return.** Y staff will be available to assist applicants in developing their plans and budget and to help grantees develop their plans for supplemental fundraising, if needed. **Only first year, sophomore, or junior Bonners are eligible to apply. Deadline for applications is early February (specific date will be set soon).**
